

Greenfield Fish and Game Club Automatic Vehicle Gate Instructions:

General Rules:

By using the vehicle gate you agree to follow the gate operating procedure and hold harmless; Greenfield Fish and Game Club inc, its Officers, Directors, Trustees, Members and Contractors.

Smile, you're on camera. Anyone who is caught not following the rules or interfering with the operation of the equipment / gate will be disciplined.

Use only your Greenfield issued card at the Greenfield Gate, no other cards will work. DO NOT SHARE your swipe card with anyone. MAKE SURE to only present your White Greenfield Membership Card. Any other cards that are physically present can also be read simultaneously and will confuse the reader and your authorization will fail. In other words, if you have multiple RFID cards for other clubs that use card swipe, physically separate them from your Greenfield card and only present the Greenfield card to the reader.

Incoming traffic (traffic going toward the range) has the right of way and should be let through the gate first.

The gate is motorized and IT has the right of way by default. You are responsible for keeping the gate and your vehicle from touching. The gate will not stop if it hits an obstruction or bumps your vehicle. DO NOT touch the gate or moving parts with you body. DO NOT drive toward or past the gate while it is in motion. DO NOT BUMP THE GATE TO TRY AND MAKE IT GO FASTER. THIS WILL DESTROY THE EQUIPMENT.

ONE VEHICLE PER GATE CYCLE. DO NOT TAILGATE OTHER VEHICLES or try to pass multiple vehicles through the gate when it is opened via a single card swipe.

It is possible that the gate will be “locked out” in the open position during club events, maintenance or free passage. This will be indicated by signage / lights when in use.

All card swipes are recorded electronically and gate movements are recorded on camera.

If the gate fails to open or fails to close or seems to be operating incorrectly, using a phone please call: 315-724-4954 as soon as possible so that it can be fixed.

Lost or Stolen Card:

Reporting your lost or stolen card protects you and the club from liability.

Replacement cards are \$5.00 each.

Gate Use Procedure

Incoming Traffic:

Approach the gate area and slowly pull up to the card reader which is located on the left shoulder next to the yellow pole. The card reader is located on the goose-neck stanchion at about chest height and should be accessible from the drivers seat of your vehicle. Present (touch) your RFID Membership card to the small black rectangle with the red light. The card reader will “beep” when the card is read. Once the reader beeps and your card is read, the gate will activate and open. WAIT until the gate is fully open and stops moving, then drive straight through the gate area and proceed to the range. Do not hesitate or get distracted. The gate will automatically close after a preset time limit. There is ample time for one vehicle to pass through the gate in a given swipe cycle. If you are next in line, wait for the gate to cycle back closed and reset, **DO NOT SWIPE YOUR CARD WHILE THE GATE IS OPEN AND TRY TO PASS THROUGH.** If there are multiple vehicles in line waiting to enter the range they must each wait for the gate to close then swipe and pass one at a time in an orderly fashion.

Outgoing Traffic:

Approach the gate area and slowly pull off to the left in the “waiting lane” and up to the card reader which is located next to the yellow pole on the left shoulder and swipe your card to exit. If there are multiple vehicles in line waiting to enter the range; **YOU MUST WAIT FOR THEM TO SWIPE IN AND CLEAR THE AREA BEFORE YOUR PROCEED OUT.** If there are multiple vehicles in line waiting to exit the range they must each swipe and pass one at a time through the gate in an orderly fashion while yielding from the waiting lane to any incoming traffic.

Problems / Emergencies:

In the event of a life threatening emergency call 911.

In the event of a malfunction, failure or dangerous situation press the EMERGENCY STOP switch located on the front wooden board (entrance side) or on the wooden post (exit side) to de-energize the gate and using a phone, call: 315-724-4954 immediately and advise of the situation.

Emergency Open Procedure.

In the event of an emergency which requires the gate to be physically opened:

First press the EMERGENCY STOP switch located on the front wooden board (entrance side) or on the wooden post (exit side) to de-energize the gate. Once the switch is pressed in, pull the pins at the electric latch and electric actuator marked with red safety flags. Move the electric actuator out of the way and slowly swing the gate open by hand. Using a phone, call: 315-724-4954 immediately and advise of the situation.
